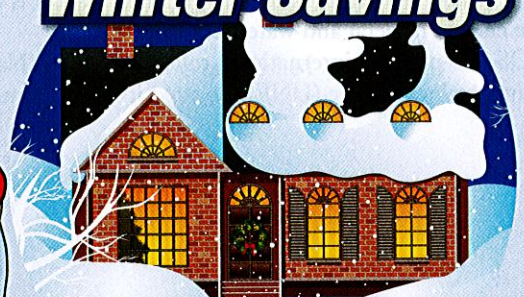

Old Man Winter doesn't have to put the pinch on your pocket book. Outsmart the cold by winterizing your home right now. Here are a few more simple ways to put the freeze on your energy bills from the experts at your local Touchstone Energy Cooperative.

- Seal cracks near windows and use weather stripping around doors and you could save as much as 25%.
- Double paned storm windows can cut the amount of heat lost in the winter by as much as 25-50%. If replacing single paned windows is out of your budget, use plastic sheeting.
- Move furniture away from exterior walls and older windows. This will keep you from feeling the draft and being tempted to turn up the heat.
- Turn off kitchen and bathroom ventilation fans when they've done their job. These fans can allow heated air to escape.
